Typically, you'd have to wait in long lines at Thanksgiving to buy your pies at the orchard, but we're bringing them directly to St. Augustine for you. A portion of the proceeds generated from pie sales will directly support our school.

If you are planning to purchase pies for your Thanksgiving celebration, please consider buying them through this fundraiser – both as a convenience for you and a way to support St. Augustine School.

Giving Back to the Community

As in past years, we are offering the opportunity to purchase pies to donate to the Lazarus House as an extension of our Turkey Dinner Drive. If you would like to donate, please indicate how many pies you'd like in the Donation box on the order form and add it to your total. We'll be working directly with the folks at the house to determine which types of pies they are most in need of. All donated pies will be delivered directly to the Lazarus House on your behalf.
