

AHERA ANNUAL NOTIFICATION

Under 40 CFR 763, subpart E, the US EPA requires that all School Building staff, teachers, students, parents and legal guardians receive annual notification of the location of the Management Plan, and updates on asbestos related activities at the school building including any response actions, reinspections, surveillances, etc.

This notice serves to inform all noted individuals of the following activities:

1. Availability of the School's Asbestos Management Plan (AMP)

The AMP is available for review at the main office at school.

2. Update on Planned Asbestos-Related Activities:

- The 6-month periodic surveillance of asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM) was performed in June 2019. The surveillance was performed by TRC Environmental Corporation.
- The most recent 3-Year Reinspection was performed June 2019 by TRC Environmental Corporation. The next reinspection will be scheduled for summer of 2022.
- Response actions performed in the school building during (enter year here) included those items that were identified in the last 3-year reinspection and included the replacement of floor tiles in closet. The work was performed by a Massachusetts DLS licensed Asbestos Contractor, TRC. All work areas passed a successful final visual inspection and air clearance testing as required by EPA AHERA and Massachusetts regulations. A copy of the abatement records and air clearance results are on file with the school's Asbestos Management Plan.
- Future planned asbestos repair and removal projects in the school building for the year include: filling the voids left by chipped and missing pieces of floor tile in an office, attaching a warning label to the block covering the boiler breach.
