Grade N/PreK: 1 jar of peanut butter, 2 cans of tuna fish **Grade K**: 1 jar of peanut butter, 2 packages of juice boxes

Grade 1: 1 can of potatoes, 1 package of stuffing, 2 cans of gravy

Grade 2: 2 packages dry soup, 2 packages of plain pasta

Grade 3: 2 cans of green beans, 2 cans of corn

Grade 4: 2 cans of mixed vegetables, 2 cans of peas

Grade 5: 2 cans of cranberry sauce, 2 cans of beans (garbanzo, black, etc)

Grade 6: 2 cans of tomato products, 2 cans of pasta meal (ravioli, etc)

Grade 7: 4 cans of soup

Grade 8: 2 cans of tuna fish, 1 can of coffee

Dear Students,

I am happy to inform you that St. Augustine School plays are back!! If you are in first through eighth grade and you are interested in taking part in our school production of **The Frog Prince and Beyond**, here's the information you need to know.

The performances will take place on **Friday, April 5th** and on **Saturday, April 6th**. We will be holding rehearsals every Monday and Tuesday starting on **Tuesday, January 2nd**. If you are cast in the play, you will get a full rehearsal schedule at the time of casting. You must make yourself available for rehearsals. Most of them will be from 3:00 - 4:30 in the Gym. You must also have transportation home promptly at 4:30 pm.

Auditions will be in the Gym, from 3:00 to 4:30 P.M. on **Monday, November 27th** for those of you in grades 5-8 and **Tuesday, November 28th** for those of you in grades 1-4. Please try to make it on your scheduled day, but if you are unable to, email Ms. Casey.

All you need to do for the audition is find a poem you enjoy and practice reading it so that you are familiar with the words to recite it clearly and expressively. You do not need to memorize it, but you may if you wish. Also, please prepare a verse and chorus of a song that best showcases your voice. The song does not have to be memorized either. Please either prepare your song a capella or to an instrumental version online that you can send Ms. Casey the link to. At the audition, we will play a couple of theatre games before I will ask each participant to recite his or her poem and sing his or her song. When you audition, we will be looking for clarity, expression, and volume (in other words, how loud you can be without shouting). There will be about 40 openings.

Does this sound good? We hope so! The auditions are open to any student in grades 1-8, so if you're interested, go to the **QR code or link and fill out the form by Monday November 20th.** Then start practicing!! We're so excited to see you on your audition day!

By the way, a production can never take place without a production team. We are putting together a talented group of people who will be in charge of **costume design**, **set design**, **and stage crew**. If any of you are more interested in that aspect of theatre work, we would LOVE to hear from you. Please complete the appropriate questions on the **same QR code or link form by Monday**, **November 20**_a.


