

## FOR YOUR INFORMATION


- Picture Day is Monday, October 23: Students received forms last week and an email went out to all families from O'Connor Studios to order photos of your children.

- ° Each weekday (Mon-Thurs) in October two winners will be drawn at random and one winner each Friday for the specified amount on the calendar above.
